ORDER ON REMAND

THIS MATTER, having come before the Court by way of Order to Show Cause and Verified Complaint; and the Court, having heard argument and having entered an Order on June 1, 2018; and a part of the Order having been reversed and remanded by the Appellate Division; and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 9th day of April, 2019;

ORDERED, that the portion of the Order of June 1, 2018 denying Plaintiff's application to require the Morris County Clerk to print all future mail-in ballots in the Town of Dover in both English and Spanish, so long as more than 10 percent of registered voters speak Spanish as their primary language, is vacated; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Court's Order of June 1, 2018 be, and hereby is, amended, as follows:

Hereinafter, where N.J.S.A. 19:23-22.4 requires that sample primary ballots be printed in Spanish as well as English, the Morris County Clerk shall cause the official primary ballots, including mail-in ballots, to be printed in Spanish and English; and it is further

ORDERED, that all other provisions of the Court's Order of June 1, 2018 remain in full force and effect.
