**ORDER**

This matter being presented to the Court by Defendant Atlantic County Democratic Committee by way of motion seeking relief from the Court's Order of April 9, 2020, on the basis that the full membership of the Atlantic County Democratic Committee has approved an amendment to its Bylaws extending the term of current members and officers of the County Committee, and the Court having considered the papers presented by the Atlantic County Democratic Committee, and for good cause shown;

It is on this 12th day of May, 2020, ORDERED THAT:

1. Based on the decision of the membership of the Atlantic County Democratic Committee of May 7, 2020, to amend its bylaws, the Plaintiffs have represented to the Court that they will not further object to the Atlantic County Democratic Committee: (a) postponing the elections of members of the Atlantic County Democratic Committee, initially scheduled to be held at the 2020 Democratic Primary, to the 2021 Democratic Primary; nor (b) to the reorganization meeting being held thereafter in compliance with the timing requirements set-forth by Title 19. In not objecting to this postponement of the election or the reorganization meeting, the Plaintiffs are not conceding or admitting the validity of any other future action or consequence flowing from the aforesaid Bylaws amendment.

2. Based on the foregoing, Paragraph 2 of the Court's April 9, 2020 Order is hereby vacated to the extent it required the Atlantic County Democratic Committee to hold elections for County Committee members in the 2020 Democratic Primary. The County Clerk will prepare the ballot in conformity with this Order.

3. The election for members of the Atlantic County Democratic Committee shall be held at the 2021 Democratic Primary and the reorganization shall be held thereafter in compliance with the timing requirements set-forth in Title 19.

4. The Clerk of Court shall mark this case as closed.

5. A copy of this Order shall be served on all counsel of record via eCourts.

6. The motion filed by the Atlantic County Democratic Committee is moot and there is no need for the hearing on May 14, 2020.
