Dear Senate President Sweeney and Speaker Coughlin,

Thank you for this afternoon's letter regarding implementation of the November 23, 2021 resolution issued by the State Capitol Joint Management Commission ("JMC"). As you noted in the letter, the November 23 resolution requires that legislators, State House employees, and members of the public provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination status before they are granted entry to the State House Complex.

Your letter raised concerns whether New Jersey State Police (NJSP) personnel will be checking proof of vaccination for those seeking to enter the Complex. I can assure you they will. I have consulted with the NJSP Superintendent, Colonel Patrick Callahan, and you may disregard prior communications that conflict with this assurance, which were based on a previous plan for ensuring compliance with the resolution.

Please note that, to facilitate entry to the Complex, NJSP will accept proof of vaccination in either hard copy or electronic form. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
