**ORDER OF  
FORFEITURE OF EMPLOYMENT**

Defendant, **Bernice Toledo**, (DOB (██████)), having been a Judge for the Surrogate's Court for Passaic County, having been charged with one count of Falsifying or Tampering with Records, in violation of 2C:21-4a, and such offense having occurred while defendant was acting in her capacity at Passaic County Surrogate's Court, and having involved or touched upon her public office, position or employment; and Defendant having entered Pre-Trial Intervention, and having consented to the entry of this Order, and good cause having been shown therefor;

It is on this 21 day of June, 2022

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 2C:51-2*, the Defendant shall forfeit any and all public employment and shall be forever disqualified from holding any office or position of honor, trust or profit under the State or any of its administrative or political subdivision

The defendant further understands that if she should make any future application for public employment or should he take any affirmative steps to seek to run for or be appointed to public office in violation of this Order, she will be subject to an additional charge under *N.J.S.A. 2C:29-9a* (fourth-degree Contempt of Court).




